This term's priorities are:

- Settling into class
- Learning the rules and expectations in school

Ways to help your child at home:

- Teach your child to get dressed independently
- Using the toilet independently
- Practise using a knife and fork to eat their food
- Practise having to wait patiently for things

You can help your child in Literacy by:

- Helping them to recognise and write their name
- Reading stories to them everyday
- Learn rhymes such as: Hey Diddle, Diddle, Humpty Dumpty
- Encourage them to take turns to talk in conversations

You can help your child in Maths by:

- Counting objects at every opportunity e.g. how many eggs are in the box? Can you put 6 cakes on the plate?
- Playing simple board games e.g. Snakes and Ladders
- Comparing different amounts of objects and talking about amounts and quantities having more or fewer objects in them.
