Your child will know:

- That dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes.
- To understand the conditions for a fair test.

Your child will be able to:

- Compare materials by their properties, describing their choices using scientific terminology.
- Dissolve and separate liquid to form a solution.
- Explain how some changes result in the formation of a material that is either reversible or irreversible.

Your child will know:

- How to keep safe online
- How to recognise how data is transferred across the internet
- Different ways of working together online
- That sharing information online can help people to work together
- How computers use addresses to access websites

- Create a cover for their reading albums celebrating their reading journey.
