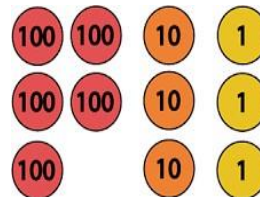
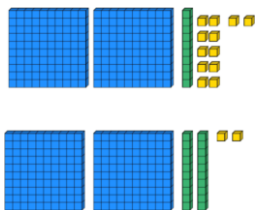

Key Vocabulary: partition, place value, greater than, less than, part, whole, addition, subtraction, equal, order, compare.

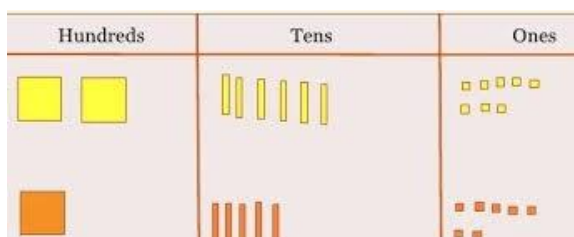
